## Canvases

Most acrylic paintings require a pre-primed stretched canvas (medium duck), Archival (museum quality) seal. I prefer **Fredrix Red Label**. When doing portraits, birds, and animals, I use **Fredrix Blue Label** ultra-smooth canvases. If you cannot find these canvases, we offer them at the Yarnell Studio.
